

## COMPUTER GRAPHICS PROJECT USING MS WORD – PERSONAL EXPRESSION

File Name: Graphic Design – Personal Expression (note: this assignment has no heading or title)

Page Orientation: Your Choice

Page Setup/Margins: 1 Inch margins (all sides)

1. Insert Your Picture (You may use picture as “fill effect” in shape if preferred)
  - Layout – In Front of Text
  - Size as you like
  - Add a frame to your picture (unless it’s in a shape already)
2. Add first name to design using textbox – format as you like
3. Insert WordArt - Choose, and complete, a statement such as the following
  - I am (not) .....
  - I wish .....
  - I (don’t) believe .....
  - I (don’t) want.....
  - I love (hate) .....
  - I like (dislike) .....
4. Insert some ClipArt which represents/reinforces your statement above. You may get a graphic from the Internet using copy/paste or saved to your folder. Do not go overboard with clipart! You may change/manipulate clipart as you are able.
5. Add at least two AutoShapes to your project. Format as you please.
6. You may add whatever attributes you like to the objects you add.
  - Size
  - Fill colors/patterns/textures/gradients
  - Line color/styles
  - Arrow styles
  - Rotate, flip, align, distribute and order as you like
7. Add a page border, use options to set the border as you like
8. Arrange and order your graphic objects in a visually pleasing and complimentary manner.
9. Remember to pay attention to margins, do not place items outside margins or they will not print properly.
10. Use grouping and layering as appropriate for your design.
11. Consider the Elements & Principles of Design in creating your design.
